We also suggest inserting a meeting directory in each copy.

To find boxes near you, check this <u>map</u> on Little Free Library's website. Clicking on a red droplet icon displays the address and the "charter number" of that box, along with a photo and sometimes a description. Blue dots indicate multiple boxes close together; zoom in closer to see each one.

We have a <u>Google Sheet</u> where you can search for the charter number. If the charter number isn't found, please add it at the bottom, along with the address. Note that some "renegade" book boxes are not registered with Little Free Library; in those cases, please just enter the address to which you have delivered a book. When you have placed a book, I ask that you record your name (first name, last initial) and the date next to that address. This will avoid double-headed deliveries. If all this seems like too much tech, just <u>email</u> me and I will update the online list.

Thanks in advance to all who participate in this method of "carrying the message!"
